

Franklin Lakes, NJ Memorial Day Parade and Ceremony

The 66th Franklin Lakes Memorial Day Parade will begin at Commerce Street at 9:00 A.M. sharp on the morning of Monday, May 26, 2008, and will proceed down Franklin Avenue to VFW Post 5702. We hope that you are looking forward to the Memorial Day Parade and Ceremony as much as we are. Here are some details for organizations and marchers concerning the Parade that we ask you to consider:

- Since traffic congestion is a problem on Commerce Street, we are asking all participants to arrive early. In order to protect the safety of all participants, drivers of vehicles are reminded not to discharge passengers directly onto Commerce Street.
- All organizations wishing to participate in the Parade should begin assembling by 8:30 A.M., and should be ready to start marching no later than 8:45 A.M.
- The Memorial Day Ceremony will begin at VFW Post 5702 as soon as possible after the Parade has ended.
- After the Parade is completed, all Color Guards are asked to assemble in the grassy area behind the tank.
- Prior to the Memorial Day Ceremony, all Scout groups are asked to assemble in front of the Monument.
- All Parade participants and attendees are invited to stay for refreshments after the Memorial Day Ceremony is completed.

We all hope that the weather will be pleasant on May 26, 2008. If there is inclement weather, and the Parade has to be cancelled, the Franklin Lakes Police Department will place the electronic sign board on Franklin Ave with a message indicating the Memorial Day Parade is cancelled.
